RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Wolfville pursuant to Section 169 of Chapter 309 of the Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia, 1967, the Towns Act that the following bylaw be and the same is hereby enacted and that the Clerk be and is hereby instructed to forward same to the Minister of Municipal Affairs and the Minister of Highways with a request for their approvals thereof.

Bylaw Number 42

- 1. THAT the Council do close to public use a street or a portion of the said street known as Wickwire Avenue.
- 2. THAT the street or portion thereof hereby closed to public use pursuant to Section 1 of this Bylaw is as follows:

All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the Town of Wolfville, in the County of Kings, in the Province of Nova Scotia, and being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the East side of Wickwire Avenue at the Northwest corner of Lot 23B;

THENCE along the East boundary N 80 15' East a distance of 88.5 feet to a point where the street turns;

THENCE along the South boundary of Wickwire Avenue S 80° 45' East a distance of 25.3 feet to a point being the point of beginning of a cul-de-sac to be closed off;

THENCE curving Southeastward on the perimeter of an arc having a radius of 43 feet until it meets the perimeter of a circle having a radius of 61 feet and continuing around said circle anti-clockwise until it meets the South boundary of Wickwire Avenue;

THENCE North 80° 45' West along the South boundary of Wickwire Avenue to the point of beginning of the cul-de-sac.

3. THAT the portion of Wickwire Avenue as described in Section 2 of this Bylaw be closed and that all rights of public user heretofore as a street in the lands hereinbefore more particularly described are forever extinguished and the said Town may sell and convey the street or any portion thereof.
